AUDITORS

Riders should be comfortable being instructed in front of a large audience, as there may be 100 or more auditors in attendance. Horse owners and/or grooms are NOT exempt from auditing fees. If not selected to ride, applicants are strongly encouraged to audit, but please do not send in auditor registrations until you have been informed that you have not been selected to ride. DEADLINES AND SELECTION PROCESS

Heather must receive complete applications and videos (VHS or DVD) on or before the dates shown below in order to be considered. We are not responsible for late or misdirected mail, faxes, or e-mail. Applications and videos are not reviewed until after the deadline submission. We will notify all applicants as soon as the selection process is completed, no later than four weeks prior to the clinic. For fastest notification, please provide a current e-mail address on your application. We will not publish or release the names of applicants not selected, nor will we inform third parties (such as horse owners) as to the status of an application, without the written consent of the applicant. Videos will not be returned unless a self-addressed stamped envelope is included (make sure there is enough postage!). The final deadline for video submission is April 19, 2010. Applicants will be notified of selection by May 17, 2010. Videos should be mailed to Heather Petersen, 12395 Gull Lane, Peyton, CO 80831.

FEES AND CANCELLATIONS

The clinic fee is \$160, which includes one clinic ride per day, lunch for each day and some snacks and should be made out to 2 White Feet. The clinic fee does not include stabling, hotel, transportation or additional food costs. Payment must be sent with application. Payment will be processed within ten days of selection. Should checks not be good, the rider will be assumed to have cancelled and the first alternate will be selected to take their place. It is necessary to send payment with this application. Riders who need to cancel after confirming their participation should notify Heather as soon as possible. Riders canceling will receive a refund, minus a \$25.00 processing fee, in the event a replacement rider can be found. If no replacement is available, the rider will not receive a refund unless canceling due to verifiable medical or veterinary reasons. Stabling will be available on site at \$35 per night/day. RV hook-ups are also available on sight for \$35 per night. Once participation in the clinic is confirmed arrangements will be made for stabling, etc.

FORMAT AND SCHEDULE

This clinic is open to all riders, all levels, all breeds, all divisions. The format will consist of two horses presented at most levels in 45 – 60 minute blocks each day. Clinic hours are generally 8:00 am – 5:00 pm, with a break for lunch and usually two short breaks. The clinicians will field questions between rides. Riders must participate in the entire clinic; it is not possible to apply to ride for one session only. Horse should be braided. Boots and wraps are permitted. Riders should wear very nice clinic attire.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

Riders must ride the horse listed on their application, or if substitution is needed, must receive permission from Janet Foy and Heather Petersen to ride a horse that is capable of the equivalent level or skill, and with whom they have a history of instruction. Riders may apply with more than one horse.
