Please remember that there are two separate shows and you must fill out an entry form for each show. Please specify your status. If not specified, you will be placed in the Open (O) division. O=Open, J=Junior, A= Adult Amateur (proof of AA with USEF card required), Q=Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Championships (proof of USEF/USDF membership/registration required for participants and horses) FEES: Intro \$35 per test, Training - Fourth \$40 per test; FEI & Freestyle \$45 per test; Sport Horse and Materiale Classes \$35, Equitation Class \$25. Office fee per entry \$30. Late or change fee \$25; Trailer-in (per horse) fee \$10; GAIG/USDF Qualifying fee \$10; USEF drug fee (per horse) \$15; Returned checks \$50; USEF non-member fee \$30; USDF non-member fee \$20; Make checks payable to The Collectives. Mail entry to Secretary. Please include a SASE.

SHOW COMMITTEE: The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes; limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries. Every horse entered will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Horse Show Management is not to be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. **ENTRIES:** Accepted on first come, first served basis, based on (readable) postmark. Post entries (postmarked after closing date) will be accepted on a space available basis with late fee. Once the competition is filled a wait list will be established. Wait list will be maintained through July 3, 2009. Current 2009 entry form must be used. Proof of memberships and horse registrations must be included with entry and current negative Coggins, if required, for all out-of-state horses. **IF RIDING FREESTYLE INCLUDE A COPY OF QUALIFYING TEST.** If entry is incomplete, horse/rider combo will be placed on the wait list until required paperwork is received. **TIMES:** Provisional times will be mailed in your SASE. Official times will be posted at the show office - updated each morning at least 1 hour before first ride. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETITOR TO CHECK OFFICIAL RIDE TIMES DAILY.** Numbers required at all times when horse is outside of stall. Express entries should waive signature. Adequate time intervals cannot be guaranteed when riders enter more than one horse in any class. All ownership cards must be available for inspection and included with entry. **REFUNDS:** Up through closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to day of prior to competition, **CLASS FEES WILL BE REFUNDED ONLY IF RIDE(S) CAN BE FILLED FROM WAITLIST.** Qualifying fees and drug fee (if horse is not on show grounds) refunded. During competition days - **NO REFUNDS.** Office fees are non-refundable. Wait list riders' fees will be fully refunded if they do not make it into the competition. **AWARDS:** Ribbons up to fifth place, prize and/or money for first place provided there are three entries per class. Prizes awarded at show. **OUT OF STATE:** Copy of Coggins and Health Certificate required. **ARENAS:** One, 20 x 60 sand footed indoor competition, one 20 X 60 outdoor sand footed competition and one large outdoor warm-up. Only horses with entries will be permitted in the arenas. **STABLING:** 12' x 12' covered stalls. \$25 per night. Hay and shavings available upon request. Contact Alison Child for details. (435) 640-3287. **HOOK-UPS:** Full hook-ups available for camping, call Alison Child for more details.

Go to about .5 miles to Southfield Road (1200 West, right after park on left) and go left. Event Center will be on your left. Use the 3rd driveway on your left from the corner to enter the grounds. From Provo take a left on 100 South and follow directions above.

- Class 9: Three Year Old Colts and Geldings (born in 2006)
- Class 10: **Colt Champion / Great American / USDFBC Qualifier**
1st two places from classes 6, 7, 8, 9 (no class fee)
- Class 11: **Young Horse Champion** – 1st two places from classes 5, 10 (no class fee)

Mature Horse/Breeding Classes

- Class 12: Four Year Old and Older Broodmares with or without foals (mares only to be judged)
- Class 13: Four Year Old and Older Maiden and Yeld Mares (not nursing or currently in foal)
- Class 14: **Champion Mare / Great American / USDFBC Qualifier**
1st two places from classes 12, 13 (no class fee)
- Class 15: Four Year Old and Older Stallions
- Class 16: **Champion Stallion / Great American / USDFBC Qualifier** – 1st two places from class 15 (no class fee)
- Class 17: **Mature Horse Champion** –
1st two places from classes 14, 16 (no class fee)
